The topic of this event will be ***Tax Sustainability in the EU and International Context***, and it will be hosted by Department of Business Law, School of Economics and Management, Lund University.

The aim of this conference is to bring together researchers focussing on a variety of aspects related to sustainability in an EU and international tax law context to increase the body of knowledge in this field, foster new collaborations and strengthen scientific networks.
